Eligibility: Third-year GI fellows or junior faculty in the United States whose appointments began after July, 2001, and who have demonstrated the ability to conduct research in the areas of upper GI, lower GI, outcomes, endoscopy, or hepatobiliary research by publishing an important research paper in any of these areas. Previous REGAL Award winners are not eligible.

Awards: Up to 15 winners will each receive a \$5,000 cash award plus travel and lodging to attend a symposium on October 6-8, 2006, in Chicago, Illinois, where they will present a summary of their research. No more than two winners may be chosen from any institution and no more than one winner per research area at a single institution.

Submission Package:

The submission package must contain four items:

1. A completed copy of the application form (see below)
2. A copy of a single published article from the last five years (or an in-press research paper and the acceptance letter) in one of the research areas
3. The signature of the research sponsor or division/department chair
4. A brief biographical sketch of the applicant, no more than two pages in length

Publications:

- Nominees must be the key author on the research publication or preprint
- Each nominee must select one category:
Upper GI, Lower GI, Endoscopy, Outcomes, or Hepatobiliary Research
- An original reprint of the publication (or preprint with a copy of the editor's acceptance letter) must be submitted to the meeting organizer, Brookfield Resources, LLC, at the address below
- By way of application, applicants agree that they will attend the awards symposium on October 6-8, 2006, in Chicago and prepare a 10-minute slide presentation of their work

Brief biography:

- A brief biographical sketch of the applicant should be prepared in NIH grant style, no more than two pages in length

Signature of faculty sponsor:

- A signature of the department chair or research sponsor must be included in the submission package
